Minutes May 9, 2016

Meeting called to order at at 4:05 p.m.

Minutes for April 11, 2016 approved (Motion: Stroh/Gustafson).

Treasurer report: Lori Nunez reported that there is \$690.54 balance in chapter account.

Scholarship raffle money will be deposited this week. Over \$1000 in raffle tickets were sold.

Patti Stroh discussed the importance of employees knowing the 20 day Ed Code parameters: Classified employee being asked to work more hours beyond their normal daily schedule for more than 20 consecutive days are entitled to maintain those hours on a regular daily basis.

Vacation carryover: Payroll Office is changing the notification format for Vacation Carryover. Generic letters will be sent to each employee, but will no longer be personalized with employee's tabulated accrual. It is the responsibility of the employee to check their vacation accrual on pay stubs to determine how many vacation hours they wish to carryover.

Work Calendar – For DOSA, 10 month and 11 month employees : Individual work calendars will be replaced with a simple memo from Payroll Office outlining work days for the school year. Memo will not need to signed by employee.

Classified Employee of the Year: Mitch Hicks, who will also be retiring in June, is being recognized at the May 19th School Board Meeting. In addition, Rocky is organizing a surprise BBQ Potluck for him on June 1st from 12:00-2:00 p.m. at Support Services. Negotiations update: Patti Stroh reported that final written versions of contractual items are still being worked on by CSEA Rep Lacey Gillespie, and the District. Contract will be ready for chapter voting approval in June.

CSEA Senior Student Scholarship recipients: Lori Nunez reported that the Scholarship interview day was exceptional. Based on essays from Leffingwell and CUHS Interviews the 3 senior students are suggested to receive scholarship money.
