CSEA Resolution Bulletin: Pending a U.S. court decision , CSEA may be increasing state monthly dues to \$11 per month. CSEA employees earning less than \$2450 month will not see an increase. Lawsuit involves a CTA (teacher) member who challenges compulsory union service fee dues law saying it "undermines free speech". If decision finds for the Plaintiff (teacher) – this could result in millions of lost funds for CSEA operations and staffing.
