

COAST UNION HIGH SCHOOL * STUDENT/PARENT CONTRACT

I, (please print your first and last name) _____, as a member of the 2010 graduation class of Coast Union High School, wish to participate in the commencement exercises on June 4, 2010 and agree to comply with Coast Union campus rules and regulations and dress regulations noted in the student handbook.

I understand that if I fail to participate in rehearsal or fail to comply during rehearsal, at the ceremony, or at any school sponsored activities (such as the Prom and Grad Night), I will be excused from the Commencement ceremonies and will not receive my diploma until a parent conference has been held with the school administration during the week of June 7, 2010.

GUIDELINES FOR COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

1. I understand that participation in the commencement exercise is voluntary.
2. I will not engage in any disruptive activities during school-sponsored activities or events (i.e. Prom, Grad Night), graduation rehearsal, or during ceremony.
3. I will not engage in an activity that is a violation of Education Code 48900, which results in suspension from school.
4. I will respect the premise that all seniors are entitled to a dignified and memorable graduation ceremony.
5. I will dress for the graduation ceremony according to the following guidelines:

Ladies

Dress, coordinated skirt and blouse or pantsuit, and dress shoes. No beach shoes or shoes without a back strap.

Gentlemen:

Long pants, dress shoes, dress shirt or sport shirt with collar (tie suggested, but not mandatory). No jeans or beach shoes.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL EVENTS

1. I understand that attendance at extracurricular events is voluntary and a privilege.
2. I understand that participation will not be allowed if I have two or more unsatisfactory citizenship marks, a Step 4 discipline contract in any class, or have been suspended from school pursuant to Education Code 48900 infraction.
3. I understand that if I receive an unexcused absence (cut) or excessive unexcused tardies, I will be suspended from participation in the next extra curricular activity, (extra curricular activities include Grad Night, Prom and graduation).
