- 3.1 Presentation/Open Discussion: Playing Fields/Grass
Presenter, Mark Rehbein, CEO, Rehbein Environmental Solutions International

In the absence of Mark Rehbein, who was unable to present due to a death in his family, Superintendent Adams proceeded with the discussion on the playing fields. He gave a recap on the grass growth and the challenges we have experienced with getting fields up to speed. He shared that on April 4, 2009 the lower field will be open for use by Little League and April 6 students at the grammar school will be using the lower field for P.E. classes. We will rotate activities on that field until we see how it responds to the use. We will hold off on using the middle field a little longer allowing the grass to get thicker in some of the exposed areas. The brick dust issue on the infield portion of the lower field has been resolved, and all high school fields are looking great.
