isolation criteria listed below.

Individuals should use the following criteria for release from isolation and return to work, school, or other activities following COVID-19 infection:

- I attest that at least 10 days have passed since my symptoms first appeared (or since my positive COVID-19 test if I have not had symptoms)
- I have not had a temperature 100°F or higher or felt feverish in the last 24 hours AND
- I have not taken any fever-reducing medication (such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen) in the last 24 hours **AND**
- I have remained asymptomatic over the course of my COVID-19 illness OR my symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, shortness of breath, chills, fatigue, muscle aches, loss of smell/taste, headache, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea) are markedly improved.
