<u>Job Summary:</u> Under the direction of an assigned supervisor, assists a certificated teacher in providing support to students with development and then day to day operations of student run enterprises.

Qualifications:

Required:

- 4. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions in English

Desirable:

- 1. Experience in youth activities
- 2. Bilingual in Spanish

Essential Functions:

- 1. Plans and implements daily workflow for the print shop.
- 2. Assists certificated personnel in providing support to students in a high school program to develop and maintain student run enterprises.
- 3. Reinforces material originally taught by certificated personnel.
- 4. Coordinates calendars and facilities management to insure that programs fit into school schedules.
- 5. Participates in planning and implementation meetings to help define, refine and implement the development of student run enterprises.
- 6. Assists students in operation of technology and equipment required for student run enterprises.
- 7. May be required to work a varied schedule to assist with client driven services.
